Christine Fontaine and Gérald Ledent's teaching at the Faculty of Architecture-LOCI University of Louvain, with colleagues Abdelmajid Boulaioun, Cécile Chanvillard, is at the intersection of several courses in Design, History and Theory. One of these courses, *Architecture & composition*, enables the students to read and draw architectural building types.

This workshop held in Naples, took inspiration from the *knowledge through drawing* produced in the course *Architecture & edifices* at LOCI this first semester. The production illustrates the composition elements of Ferdinando Sanfelice's (1675-1748) baroque architecture. The "catalog" produced helped the students to comprehend the use of specific elements of architecture in the act of composing palazzi in Naples. *Entrances, Courtyards, and Stairs* were the main elements highlighted in this study.

In the framework of the group *composition: palazzi* for 4th International Conference and Workshop in Naples, the students were therefore invited to interpret in a contemporary way these elements on a specific site between vico dei Giganti and vico dei Girolomino in the historical center.


For one the four scenarios of densifying a Greco-Roman square plot, each group was in charge of testing three variations of stairs – compact, linear and gallery developed as a promenade.

The "catalog" obtained through the collective work of the group helps to build understanding of the choices necessary in the act of composition. This typological repository helps the student to situate his or her action in the history and knowledge of the discipline and enables the formulation of a critical posture over the typological and morphological background, to develop an architectural project informed by current issues.


Through the exercise of *composition/decomposition* of elements, one can understand architecture as a cultural production and witness the choices of the architect facing the choices of architectural elements and their importance in the definition of types, their symbolism and materiality. From the study and composition of buildings, sometimes ordinary, sometimes singular, but still with an original architectural quality, the study aims to produce shareable knowledge, understanding the additional dimension that architecture brings to mere building. This *production of knowledge through drawing* aims to enrich the discipline of our contemporary understanding and critical reading as well as composition of edifices.

Our repertory consists of a series of drawings, according to three classical means of representation, interrogating elements of the edifice:


- The orthographic projection produces a complete flattening of the object studied and its uses.
- The axonometric projection produces a distance from the object that allows manipulation in space. This particular view, deliberately partial, shows the materiality of the object.
- The collage produces an intimate relation to the object and a speculative vision of its interpretation. It extracts a singular quality and carries it to the level of principle.




Bartolomeo Capasso, La Tavola storica di Napoli greco-romana, 1904




The greco-roman urban block, principle and reality






Plot organisation within the block, principle and reality


